

South Ridge Common Area Positive Behavior Expectations

Area/Rule	Be Respectful	Be Responsible	Be Resilient
Hallways	*Keep hands, feet, and objects to self *Voices off *Hold the door open for the person behind you	*Follow adult directions *Walk single file down the right side of the hall *Walk facing forward with your hands at your side	*Have a pass if you are not with a teacher *Go straight to your destination
Arrival/Departure	*Follow adult directions *In the gym, sit quietly in line, and remain in line until dismissed *At car pick up, wait patiently in your grade's line	*Walk safely on crosswalks and sidewalks *Walk quietly into the building *In the morning, walk directly to the gym, the playground, or the cafeteria	*Keep hands, feet, and objects to self *Always use kind words
Cafeteria	*Keep all food to self *Sit with feet on floor, pockets on bench, and body facing table *Walk with tray and hold tray with both hands *Follow recycling procedures	*Allow anyone to sit next to you *Use quiet voices *Wait in line patiently	*Get all utensils, milk, etc., when going through the lunch line *Clean your area and pick up anything that falls on the floor *Stay seated until you are dismissed
Bathroom	*Keep feet on the floor *Keep water in the sink *Wash Hands with soap and water *Flush toilet after use *Keep floors clean	*Put paper towels in garbage can *Give people privacy *Use quiet voices *Use a bathroom pass	*Return to classroom promptly *Tell an adult if supplies in the bathroom are out or if bathroom needs to be cleaned
Office	*Keep hands and feet to self *Voices off when walking through the office *Use polite words and actions	*Walk to counter *Wait quietly for adult *If sitting in the office, keep all four legs of chair on ground and face the desk	*Use hall pass if teacher sends you to the office *Enter only with permission from an adult
Playground	*Follow adult directions *Include everyone in games *Share and take turns *Voices off in line	*Always walk to and from the playground *Accept consequences for your actions *Use equipment as intended *Keep hands, feet, and objects to self *Be aware of games around you *Leave dirt, rocks, bark chips on ground	*Play games according to posted rules *Return equipment to cart * When the bell rings, pick up coats, hats, lunchboxes, etc. and line up
Play Structure	*Allow others to play with you *Share and take turns *Be aware of others around you	*Always walk on play structure *Keep hands and feet to self *Only go up the ladders *Slide on bottom, feet first, one person at a time *When hanging, have one hand on the bars at all times	*Climb down carefully when leaving the play structure *Keep hands and feet to self
Assemblies	*Keep hands, feet, and objects to self *Voices off *Eyes of the speaker *Sit on pockets	*Follow adult directions *Walk carefully up and down bleachers/stage steps *Walk to assigned seating area *Walk facing forward with your hands at your side *Use bathroom before leaving class or after assembly is over	*Enter and exit quietly *When indicated to do so, applaud for the speaker *If other students are talking during the assembly, give the quiet sign
Bus	*Follow teacher and bus driver directions *Accept consequences for your actions *Allow anyone to sit next to you *Use quiet voices and talk only to the person seated next to you	*Walk to the bus with your teacher *Stay on the side of the safety line closest to the school building *Once on the bus, walk to your seat and stay seated *Once on the bus, face forward and keep hands and feet to self	*High five teacher before entering bus *Only get up when the bus stops at your stop
